POSTER SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

We invite posters for each of the five workshop topics. Poster submissions should include a 150 - 200 word abstract and the one - page poster itself in an A4 size format. A workshop digest based upon the one - page abstract and one - page poster will be distributed to all participants of the workshop. Note that the accepted posters will NOT be included in the proceedings. Posters will be published online at the Workshop web site.
